## Return to the Māra

### Workshop Series

#### *Terms and Conditions of Enrolment*

---

*These terms and conditions apply to all participants enrolled in Return to the Māra delivered by Brittany Stembridge at Tomtit Farm, Matangi, Waikato. By paying your deposit you confirm that you have read and agreed to these terms.*

### 1. Enrolment and Deposit

---

Your place in Return to the Māra 2026 is confirmed once your \$250 deposit has been received and Brittany has sent you a confirmation email.

The deposit is non-refundable under any circumstances. It exists to hold your place in a small cohort and covers administration costs.

Paying your deposit means you have read and agreed to these terms and conditions.

### 2. Pricing and Payment

---

**Early bird pricing:** \$2,500 NZD. Available until 11 July 2026 (Matariki).

**Full price:** \$3,000 NZD from 11 July 2026.

The \$250 deposit is deducted from your total programme investment.

**Payment options:**

Pay the remaining balance in full at any time before the programme finishes.

Arrange a flexible payment plan directly with Brittany after your deposit is received.

Payment plan terms are agreed individually and confirmed in writing via email.

All prices are in New Zealand dollars. GST is included where applicable.

### 3. Cancellation and Refunds

---

**Deposit:**

Non-refundable under all circumstances.

**Balance payments:**

If you need to withdraw from the programme before it begins, the balance you have paid (excluding the deposit) will be refunded provided you notify Brittany in writing at least 30 days before the first workshop in November 2026.

If you withdraw fewer than 30 days before the programme begins, no refund of balance payments will be issued. A deferral to the next available cohort may be offered at Brittany's discretion.

**Once the programme has begun:**

No refunds are available for workshops already delivered. If you need to withdraw mid-programme, please contact Brittany directly to discuss your options.

## 4. Deferral

---

If circumstances change and you are unable to attend the November cohort, you may request a deferral to the next available Return to the Māra cohort.

Deferral requests must be made in writing to Brittany before the programme begins. Deferrals are granted at Brittany's discretion and are subject to availability in the future cohort.

Your deposit will be transferred to the new cohort. No additional deposit is required.

**Deferrals are available once only per enrolment.**

## 5. Missed Workshops

---

Life happens. If you miss a workshop, you will not receive a refund for that session.

Supporting resources from each workshop are made available to all participants after the session. If you miss a workshop, Brittany will ensure you have access to these materials.

Workshops can be transferred between cohort days by prior arrangement with Brittany.

## 6. Programme Changes

---

Brittany reserves the right to adjust workshop content, dates, or format where necessary for example, due to weather, illness, or circumstances beyond her control.

In the event a workshop needs to be rescheduled, participants will be notified as soon as possible and offered an alternative date. No refund will be issued for a rescheduled workshop.

In the unlikely event that the programme cannot be delivered, participants will be offered a full refund of all payments made including the deposit.

## 7. Health, Safety, and Conduct

---

Workshops are held outdoors and on working farm land at Tomtit Farm, Matangi. Participants are responsible for wearing appropriate clothing and footwear.

Tomtit Farm is a certified organic farm. Participants must follow all health and safety guidance provided on the day.

Return to the Māra is a community learning space. Brittany reserves the right to remove any participant from the programme without refund if their conduct is harmful to other participants or inconsistent with the values of the programme.

## 8. Photography and Testimonials

---

Brittany may photograph or film workshops for use in Tomtit Farm's marketing and social media. If you do not wish to be photographed, please let Brittany know before the workshop begins.

Any testimonials or quotes gathered through the end-of-season questionnaire will only be used with your explicit written permission, as indicated in the questionnaire itself.
